Project Account Name: Well Drilling

Actual Date Started: January 4, 2010, \$6500 US was wired for the first well. An additional \$6,500 was wired and \$5,000 brought down in cash for two more wells.

Status: Deposit paid, wells drilled, casing installed. Pump still needs to be installed at all 3 locations.

Expected Date of Completion: June 1, 2010

Summary of Activity: Funds were wired, deposit was paid to Blueridge, a local drilling company, and three wells were drilled in three separate locations in the community of Grand-Goave: Rue Broisrond Tonnerre, Rue Saint Francois/ Rue Addoquin & Impasse Amitier Thozin. Blueridge will return to install pump and pour the concrete platform within the month of May 2010.

1) What does having a community well mean to you?

"There is a shortage of water in the community. The water we had is not good. Location: Impasse Amitier, Thozin

1) What does having a community well mean to you?

"First of all, a well in this community means development to us for our community. It is very important for us, because we have always had to buy water before. And that can be difficult. If people don't have water to buy water, they have to walk many km to look for water."

2) How will this benefit you and your community?

"It will help this community by giving out more water. It allows the people to save their money. It is a gift for this community."

"A lot of people, because this is a larger area that had no water before. We don't know how many people, but they will be happy to not have to buy water."
